

Rules and Conditions of Entry

We will be running under British Riding Club Rules

1. No horse or pony to compete more than once in any one class and in no more than two classes. No horse and rider combination to compete in the 2'3'' and the 2'9''
2. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary.
3. Competitors failing to obey instructions given by fence judges, stewards, judges or other officials will be disqualified.
4. All tack must be appropriate and in good repair. Whilst mounted ALL riders must wear hunting dress or cross country colours, correct boots with heel, properly fastened hard hats conforming to BHS standards (PAS015, BSEN1384 or ASTM F1163 with kitemark or SNELL) and a body protector.
5. Medical armbands are compulsory
6. £5 deposit must be left with secretaries for number bibs
7. The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be handed in, in writing, with a deposit of £20 within 10 minutes of the results being published. The deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.
8. Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times. Young children must be supervised at all times.
9. Horses and ponies must not be left unattended in the lorry park unless secured correctly inside the trailer or box.
10. Lincomb Equestrian Cross Country Course will be closed for schooling to anyone who has entered the Hunter Trial for 2 weeks prior to the event. Anyone found disobeying this will have his or her entry refused and no refund will be given.
11. The organisers their helpers, agents, employees, landowners and all persons involved with the ride accept no liability for any injury to person, horse, or spectator, or any damage to the property of riders or spectators however caused, whether it be by negligence or otherwise. It is up to the participants and spectators to make their own insurance arrangements.
12. Entry fees cannot be refunded to intending participants who are unable to ride on the day unless a veterinary or doctors note is supplied
13. No horses or ponies under the age of 4 years old
14. The organisers reserve the right to refuse permission to start to any rider not observing these conditions or attempting to ride an unsound horse.
15. The organisers reserve the right to ask any rider to leave the course for dangerous riding or ill treatment of their animal including excessive use of the whip or abusive language.
16. In the event of cancellation of the competition due to unforeseen circumstances 50% of the entry money will be returned.

DIRECTIONS

We will be operating a one way system down Lincomb Lane.

Lincomb Equestrian is located 10 miles north of Worcester. Easily accessible from the M5 and M42 Motorways. From Junction 6 of the M5, take the A449 dual carriageway sign posted Kidderminster for approximately 8 miles, turn left at a large Roundabout just before Hartlebury, taking the A4025 to Stourport on Severn. Take the first turning left, to Ombersley Golf Course, then the next right. The car and lorry parking area will be well signposted from this point.

If you are travelling from West of the River Severn, follow the signs for Worcester through Stourport on Severn until you are on the A4025. You will pass Sandy Lane Industrial Estate, continue on this road and take the first turning on the right after Bells Farm Shop, signed Ombersley Golf Course, take the next right. The car and lorry parking area will be well signposted from this point.

Class 1- Junior 2'3''

For riders 16 years and under on the day of the competition

Fences- Max 2'3'' Entry fee- £17

Rosettes for 1st- 6th place

Class 2- Senior 2'3''

For riders 17 years and over on the day of the competition.

Class 3- Junior 2'9''

For riders 16 years and under on the day of the competition

Fences- Max 2'9'' Entry fee- £17

For riders 17 years and over on the day of the competition.
